2016 Musket Ridge MISGA Golfer of the Year (Blue-Gray Cup)

This award recognizes individuals in the Musket Ridge MISGA group of associates who played the **best golf and had significant participation** in Musket Ridge MISGA Program throughout the current season.

The winner will be the person who accumulates the most Blue-Gray points during the year. For 2016, points will awarded for all Musket Ridge MISGA Mixer events including our Opening Day Tournament. As our schedule currently stands, the season will run from March 29 (Opening Day Tournament) through the October 4 Mixer at Sparrows Point (pending additional MISGA mixers or rescheduled events).

Points will **not** be awarded for MISGA Division II or state MISGA sponsored events (for example, the two-man and ABCD).

Points are awarded based on a player's **Net Scores** compared to fellow Musket Ridge MISGA Associates in both Home and Away Mixers. For each Musket Ridge MISGA scheduled Mixer (home and away), a player who represents Musket Ridge MISGA in that mixer receives points **based on their Net Score and based on the number of Musket Ridge competitors at that event.** This is the same scoring methodology that we used last year.

Scoring Examples:

If 12 Musket Ridge Associates compete at a mixer, the number of points awarded will be 12 for low net, 11 for next low net, 10 for next low net1 for last low net.

If 25 Musket Ridge Associates compete at a mixer, the number of points awarded will be 25 for low net, 24 for next low net, 23 for next low net 1 for last low net.

Ties will combine and share place points.

Where possible, the scores for both Home and Away Mixers will be taken from the official scorecards for the Mixer. Members should make sure that the official event scorecard accurately shows their gross score.

The winner and the first two runners up of the Musket Ridge MISGA Golfer of the Year will be announced at the 2016 Musket Ridge MISGA Championship Luncheon on October 11.
